Regular meeting called to order by the presiding chairperson, Mike Weise with all members and Director of Parks and Recreation present. Minutes of the previous meeting read and approved.

A copy of resolution #5924 (Rules for use of Town of Easton Parks) was given to each member of the board. The rules were approved on April 21, 2008 by the Town of Easton Council. A copy of the rules will be sent out along with Park and Field Use permits. American Tennis Courts has the PO to start on the work at Idlewild Tennis courts. We are just waiting for the date they plan to start on the work. Rules for the tennis courts are also in Resolution #5924.

Lorraine will get with Brian Hause and ask about site plans for Idlewild Park. Then we can get with Victoria Milholland about the “wall of thanks”.

The water fountain that is located in the play area at Idlewild has been turned off. It appears that someone (unknown) has tried to work on it. There is a large concern over the sand boxes in the area and the sand being put in the fountain clogging it up. We need to get the rules up and enforce them, see about taking the sand out or removing the water fountain from that area.

Lorraine is waiting to hear from Easton Utilities what the costs and options that we have for the lights in the trees at Thompson Park.

It was decided that there are enough speed bumps about North Easton Sports Complex. We need to enforce the parking and look into putting cross walks at the main entrance to the base ball fields.

We should look into purchasing bike racks to go out to North Easton Sports Complex and have them placed in the back near the Rails to Trails and batting cages. There is an ongoing problem with children riding their bikes around the concession stand. It is not safe.

It was suggested that we check into if Chapel East Park was approved by the Council when Mike Morse was director, that the park be named after Ian Mac Morrell. He was on the Zoning Board.

Lorraine met with a couple of residents at Matthewstown Run. There has been a problem with kids playing baseball at the baseball area and the balls have been hitting homes in the area. Home owners would like this to stop. It was decided that we would try to come up with a way to physically get rid of the problem.

Since Memorial Day falls on the fourth Monday in May, the next meeting will be June 23, 2008 at 12:00
